

## Robertson County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship

### Scholarship Overview

One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to an outstanding student. The purpose of this program is to identify and encourage talented and thoughtful students who will emerge as industry leaders.

### Conditions of Eligibility

- Applicants must be a graduating high school senior
- You must be enrolled as an undergraduate student in a two or four-year institution of higher education for the entire 2018-19 academic year.
- Scholarship money will be paid directly to the university to be applied towards the student's expenses.

### Judging Process

The Robertson County Cattlemen's Association will administer the program and choose a panel of judges to review the essays and select the winners. Essays will be judged at the basis of originality, grammar, clarity of expression, accuracy, relevance of topic and the solutions offered. Judges decisions are final. The Robertson County Cattlemen's Association reserves the right to publish all or any parts of essays submitted. The following percentages of the total score will be used to evaluate the application:

- Essay = 50%
- Activity in 4-H, FFA = 50%

### Application Requirements

- Essay – write an essay of 500 words or less describing an issue confronting the beef industry in Tennessee and offer your solution.
- Activities – Attach a list showing your participation in 4-H, FFA
- References – Attach a letter of reference from a current or former instructor or industry professional.
- Application must be received by March 1, 2018.
