- Liquid bleach
- · Liquid laundry detergent (free of perfumes)
- Pens/Dry Erase Markers
- Tall kitchen trash bags
- Large trash bags
- Paper Towels
- Zip ties (all sizes)
- Stamps: "Forever" (letter & postcard)
- Printer paper
- Gift cards: Kroger, Tractor Supply, Wal-Mart, Home Depot, Lowe's, Big Lots, gas cards
- Fresh Produce (NO onions, celery, potatoes or iceberg lettuce)
- Eggs (Raw or Boiled)
- Plain Yogurt
- Jars of baby food (meat pureed)
- Live Earthworms (i.e. fishing bait)
- Live Mealworms
- Canned or dry pet food
- Unsalted peanuts (shell), walnuts and pecans (shell and unshelled)
- Tree nuts: walnuts, hickory nuts, pecans, and acorns

- Heavy-duty scissors or kitchen shears
